**ORDER GRANTING DEBTORS'
MOTION FOR EMERGENCY HEARING AND
NOTICE OF VIRTUAL HEARING ON DEBTORS' FIRST DAY MOTIONS**

On January 25, 2024, Debtors filed a *Motion of Foreign Representative for Order (I) Scheduling Hearing on Verified Petition Under Chapter 15 of the Bankruptcy Code for Recognition of a Foreign Main Proceeding and for Additional Relief and Assistant Under 11 U.S.C. §§ 105(a), 1507, and 1521 and (II) Specifying Form and Manner of Service of Notice of Hearing* (Docket No. 7) and a *Motion of Foreign Representative for an Order Granting Certain Provisional Relief* (Docket No. 8)(collectively, the "First Day Motions"). On the same day, Debtors filed a *Motion for Expedited Hearing* (the "Emergency Motion") (Docket No. 9). After review of the matters, it is hereby

ORDERED that the Emergency Motion is **GRANTED**, and a **virtual hearing** will be held regarding the First Day Motions on the **30th day of January, 2024, commencing at 2:00 P.M. via Judge Baisier's [Virtual Hearing Room](#)**.¹ It is further

ORDERED that Debtors' counsel shall serve a copy of this Order and Notice of Virtual Hearing by the method or methods (phone call, electronic mail, fax, courier, etc.) that will provide expeditious notice and service to the Debtors, any parties with a security interest in assets of any of the Debtors, any parties with pending litigation with any of the Debtors, and any parties that have filed a notice of appearance in this case. Debtors' counsel is further directed to file a certificate of service setting forth the manner and method of all such service prior to the hearing. **All noticing is required to be completed by 2:00PM EST on January 26, 2024.**

Your rights may be affected by the Court's ruling on the First Day Motions. You should read the First Day Motions carefully and discuss the matters with your attorney, if you have one in this bankruptcy case. (If you do not have an attorney, you may wish to consult one.) If you do not want the Court to grant the relief sought in the pleadings or if you want the Court to consider your view, then you and/or your attorney must attend the hearing. You may also file a written response to the First Day Motions with the Clerk at the address stated below, but you are not required to do so. If you file a written response, you must attach a certificate stating when, how and on whom (including addresses) you served the response. Mail or deliver your response so that it is received by the Clerk before the hearing. The address of the Clerk's Office is Clerk, U. S.
