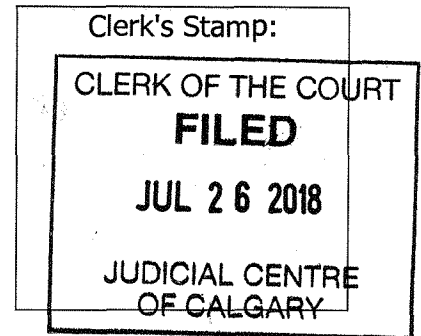

Remedy claimed or sought:

1. An Order directing the Receiver to provide the Applicant information pertaining to the theft and vandalism incident at the Mazeppa gas plant (the **Incident**).

Grounds for making this application:

2. The Applicant is a significant stakeholder in these proceedings, in the amount of \$15,058,116.08.
3. The Receiver has previously reported to this Honourable Court that the Incident occurred.
4. The Applicant owns property at the Mazeppa gas plant and as such is entitled to information pertaining to the Incident and any loss of its property.
5. The Applicant has requested certain information concerning the Incident from the Receiver and the Receiver has refused to provide some of the requested information.

Material or evidence to be relied on:

6. Affidavit of Samuel Morrow, sworn July 26, 2018.

How the application is proposed to be heard or considered:

7. In Chambers before the presiding Commercial List Justice.
