5. In order to be entitled to vote at the meeting, a creditor must prove a claim before the time appointed for the meeting.
6. A creditor who has proved a claim may indicate assent to or dissent from the consumer proposal to us at or before the meeting of creditors, and any assent or dissent we receive at or before the meeting will have the same effect as if the creditor were present and had voted at the meeting.
7. If there is no quorum at the meeting of creditors, the consumer proposal shall be deemed to be accepted by the creditors.

If the consumer proposal is accepted or deemed to be accepted by the creditors and we are not requested by the official receiver or any other interested party, within the 15 days after the acceptance or deemed acceptance, to apply to the court to have the consumer proposal reviewed, the consumer proposal shall be deemed to have been approved by the court.
