UPON the application of GRANT THORNTON LTD., in its capacity as Court appointed receiver and manager ("Receiver") of the assets, properties and undertakings of MJ's WATER HAULING CO. LTD. and 1825377 Alberta Ltd.; AND UPON having read the Application and the Fourth Report of the Receiver, dated February 16, 2018 (the "Receiver's Fourth Report"); AND UPON having read the Affidavit of Service sworn February 23, 2018 (the "Service Affidavit"); AND UPON hearing counsel for the Receiver and any other counsel present;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DECLARED THAT:

1. Service of the Notice of Application in respect of this Order and the Receiver's Fourth Report in the manner described in the Service Affidavit is hereby declared to be good and sufficient, and no other persons are entitled to be served with or given notice of the Application or served with a copy of the Fourth Receiver's Report.
2. The Receiver's activities as described in the Receiver's Fourth Report are hereby approved.
3. The fees of the Receiver and its counsel as described in the Receiver's Fourth Report are hereby approved.
4. The Receiver is hereby authorized to make the distribution to proven creditors of 1825377 Alberta Ltd. as described in the Receiver's Fourth Report ("the 182 Distribution"). The Receiver is directed to write to the creditors of 1825377 Alberta Ltd. as described in the Receiver's Fourth Report, and request that they submit a proof of claim (if not already submitted) within 30 days in order to be eligible for the 182 Distribution. If the Receiver accepts the claim, the creditor will qualify as a proven creditor in the 182 Distribution. If the creditor and the Receiver are unable to resolve the submitted claim amount, the Receiver can seek further direction from the Court.
5. The Receiver is hereby directed to forthwith pay the proven priority claims of MJ's Water Hauling Co. Ltd., as described in paragraphs 17 to 20 of the Receiver's Fourth Report, and immediately after such payment, to assign MJ's Water Hauling Co. Ltd. into bankruptcy and to carry out a distribution to proven creditors in accordance with the provisions of the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act*.
6. Service of this Order on the Service List by email, facsimile, registered mail, courier or personal delivery shall constitute good and sufficient service of this Order, and no Persons other than those on the Service List are known to be entitled to be served with a copy of this Order.
