**ORDER GRANTING DEBTORS' MOTION FOR
ORDER RECOGNIZING THE CANADIAN COURT'S FINAL ORDERS**

On February 26, 2024, Debtors filed a *Motion of Bron Media Corp. as Foreign Representative for an Order Recognizing the Canadian Court's Final Orders* (Docket No. 20)(the "Motion"). On the same day, Debtors filed a *Motion for Expedited Hearing* (the "Emergency Motion") (Docket No. 21). After review of the matters, it is hereby

ORDERED that the Emergency Motion is **GRANTED**, and a **virtual hearing** will be held regarding the Motion on the **27th day of February, 2024, commencing at 1:30 P.M. via Judge Baisier's Virtual Hearing Room.**¹ It is further

ORDERED that Debtors' counsel shall serve a copy of this Order and Notice of Virtual Hearing by the method or methods (phone call, electronic mail, fax, courier, etc.) that will provide expeditious notice and service to the Debtors, any parties with a security interest in assets of any of the Debtors, any parties with pending litigation with any of the Debtors, and any parties that have filed a notice of appearance in this case. Debtors' counsel is further directed to file a certificate of service setting forth the manner and method of all such service prior to the hearing. **All noticing is required to be completed by 5:00PM EST on February 26, 2024.**

Your rights may be affected by the Court's ruling on the Motion. You should read the Motion carefully and discuss the matter with your attorney, if you have one in this bankruptcy case. (If you do not have an attorney, you may wish to consult one.) If you do not want the Court to grant the relief sought in the pleading or if you want the Court to consider your view, then you and/or your attorney must attend the hearing. You may also file a written response to the Motion with the Clerk at the address stated below, but you are not required to do so. If you file a written response, you must attach a certificate stating when, how and on whom (including addresses) you served the response.
